

## Choosing the right solution

- \* Users with a vision impairment who prefer using the mouse to access the computer are recommended to use VisioVoice with its talking interface, typing echo and image and text zoom to access their computer.
- \* Blind and strongly vision impaired users are recommended to use the Mac OS X built-in VoiceOver screen reader in combination with the Infovox iVox voices in one or more languages to access their computer. For these users, VisioVoice may be used for its complementary features, such as the document and selection reader, as well as the text to audio file conversion.
- \* Infovox iVox provides high quality voices but offers no features of its own. Instead, it allows other software such as VoiceOver, VisioVoice and other applications to make use of natural-sounding voices.

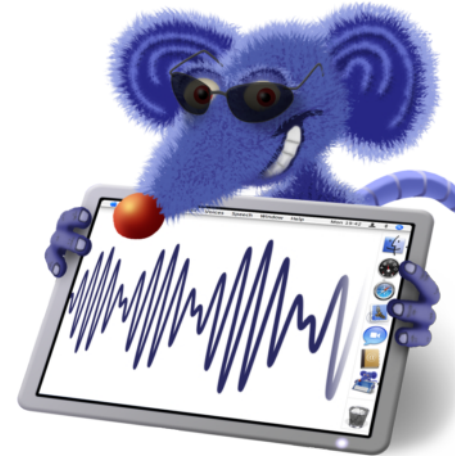

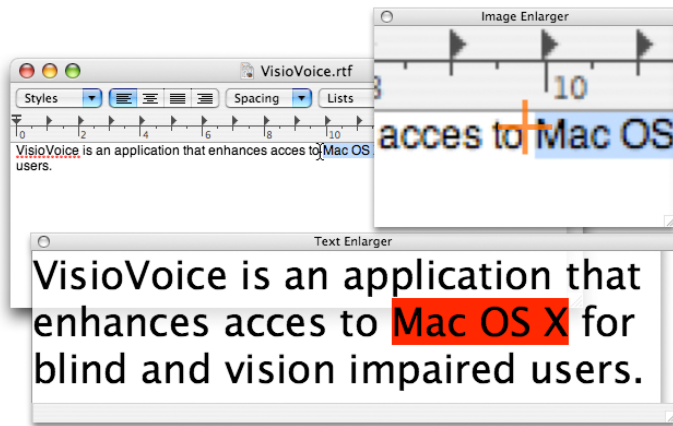

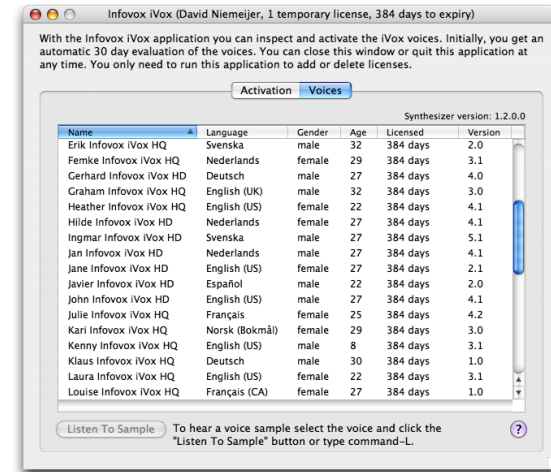
