



Back up Pictello Library to iTunes

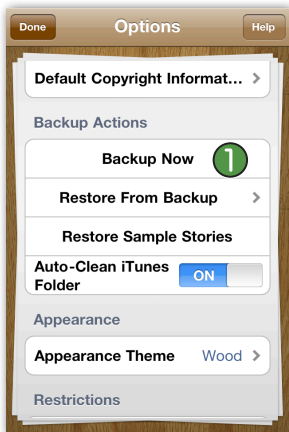
Pictello is a simple way to create talking photo albums and talking books. Each page in a Pictello Story can contain a picture, up to five lines of text, and a recorded sound or text-to-speech using high-quality voices. In this tutorial you will create a backup file that contains all the stories and folders in your library and save it to your computer.



To back up your Pictello library, go to the options screen. Tap the *Options* button **1** in the lower right corner on

any page that story and folder lists. The options screen is divided into sections. To find the Backup Actions section you will need to scroll towards the end.

The Pictello Library backup is now in a folder that will be visible through iTunes on any computer. ***It is important before you connect your device to a new computer that you disable automatic syncing to iTunes on that computer.*** See the diagram on the next page for instructions.



Tap Backup Now **1**.

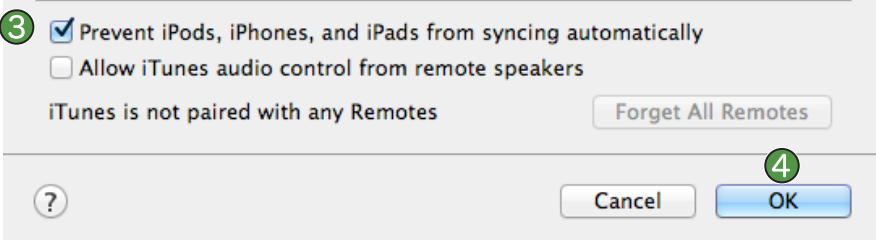
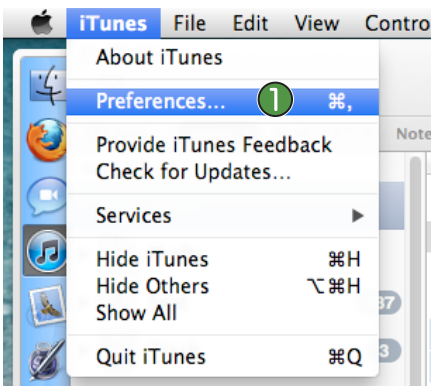


You will see a message letting you know the backup succeeded. Tap OK **1**.

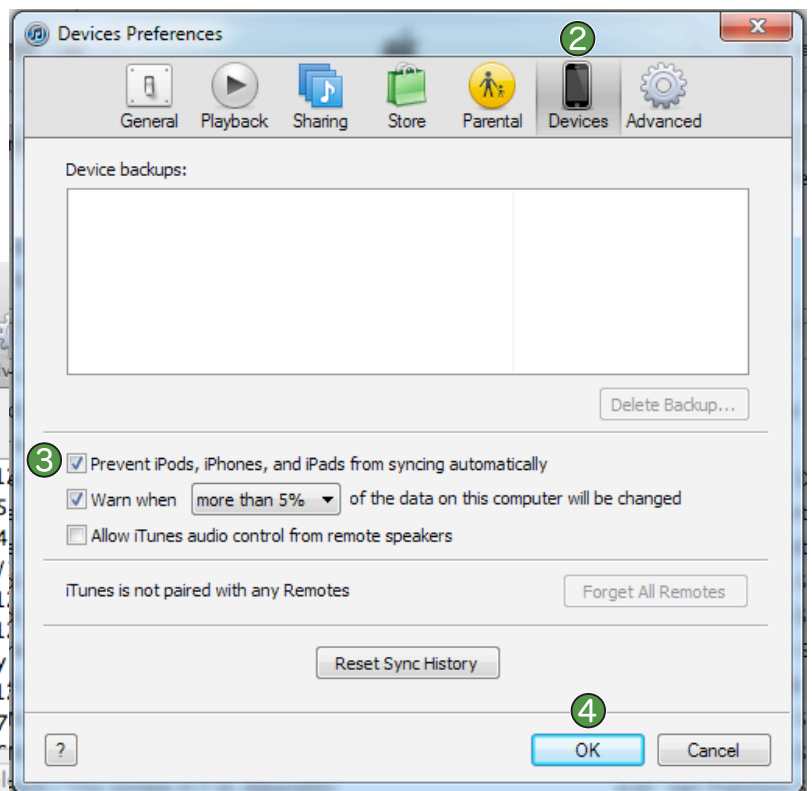
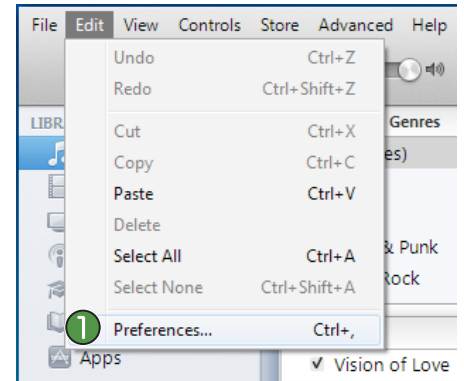


Important Note: If your device is synced to another computer, be sure to disable iTunes' automatic syncing so you do not overwrite your device's contents. Follow these steps **before** you attach your device to any new computer. To disable iTunes' automatic syncing on a Mac computer, make sure iTunes is the active application, and then select the iTunes menu at the top left corner of the screen, next to the Apple. Click on Preferences ①, then click the Devices tab ② in the window that appears. Click the check box for "Prevent iPods, iPhones, and iPads from syncing automatically" ③. Then click OK ④. On Windows, you will find Preferences at the bottom of the Edit menu ①. Note that if you leave this box checked, you will have to click the Sync button in iTunes to load new apps, music, videos, etc. onto a device from the computer since automatic syncing is disabled.

1. When iTunes opens, click on your device in the devices section of the left column in iTunes
2. Click on the Apps tab to see the apps on your device.
3. Scroll down to show the File sharing section of the App display
4. Scroll down in the list of Apps to find Pictello
5. Click on Pictello to select it
6. Documents area to the right of the Apps list will show all the Pictello stories and library backup files that have been exported to iTunes from your device. Pictello library backup files end with .ptbk
7. Click on the backup file you want to save to your computer
8. Click on the Save As... button at the bottom of the Documents area. You will be asked where on the computer you want to save the file. Once you have saved the file, you can rename it something that is meaningful to you, such as Johnny's birthday stories.ptbk You may name the file anything you like as long as you keep the .ptbk extension at the end of the file.
