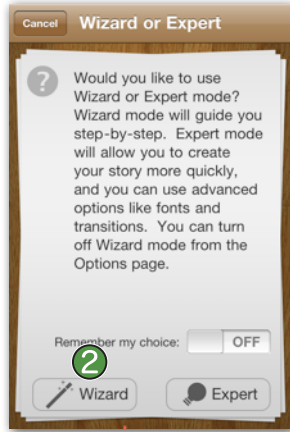




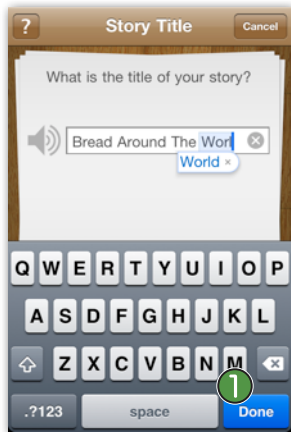
Creating a Story with Pictello Wizard

Pictello is a simple way to create talking photo albums and talking books. Each page in a Pictello Story can contain a picture, up to five lines of text, and a recorded sound or text-to-speech using high-quality voices. In this tutorial you will create a story using the Wizard editor.

Create a new Story



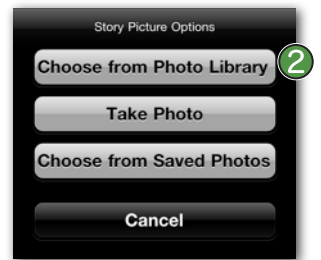
Launch Pictello, and tap the plus sign **1** in the toolbar. You will be given a choice between Wizard and Expert mode for editing. Choose Wizard mode for now by tapping the *Wizard* button **2**. Wizard mode will walk you through the story creation process step by step, but you will not have access to some advanced features. All Pictello stories can be created or changed in either Wizard or Expert mode, no matter how they were created, so you can always use Expert features later. For now leave *Remember my choice* off.



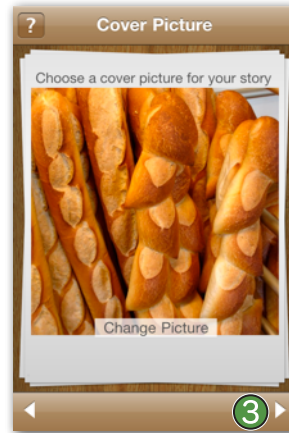
Give your story a title. Press *Done* **1** on the keyboard and the keyboard will disappear. You'll be able to see a triangle on the bottom right corner of the screen **2**.



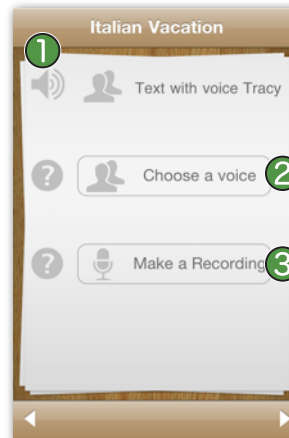
Tap on the picture frame **1** to pick or to change the cover picture for your story. You'll be given choices for where to get a picture, which depend on what kind of device you have.



Press **2** to select an image from the photo library on the device. On devices with a camera, you can take a picture directly.



Tap the next step button **3** when you're done.



Now you'll choose the sound that will be played for your title page. The currently chosen sound is at the top of the page. Press **1** speaker to hear how the currently selected choice sounds. To choose a different text-to-speech voice, press **2**. To record a sound, press **3**.



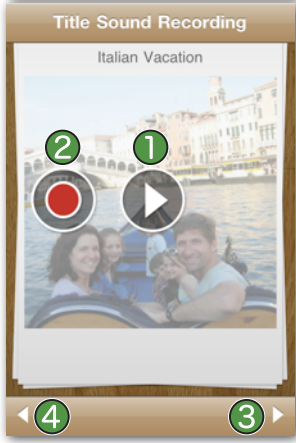
If you pressed *Choose A Voice*, you'll see a list of the voices on your device. The current choice has a checkmark 1. To hear how your title will sound with a voice, press 2 the speaker icon next to the voice. To choose a voice, touch the voice's name. Press the *Next Step* button 3, or to go back and pick a different type of sound, press the *Go Back* button 4.



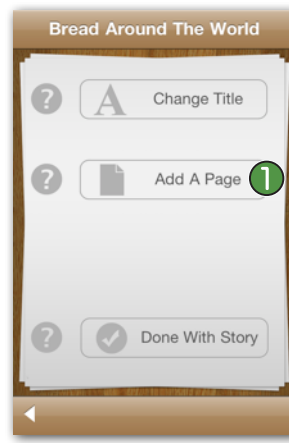
If you pressed the *Make a Recording* button, you'll see a page where you can record a sound. When you're ready to record, press the red button 1. If your device does not have a microphone, you will get an error.



A black bar will appear at the bottom of the page 1, with a red line indicating the recording level (how loud the sound is that the microphone is receiving). The *Record* button will disappear, and a *Stop* button 2 will appear. Press the *Stop* button when you're done recording.



When you stop your recording, the *Record* button will reappear and a *Play* button will also appear. You can listen to your recording by pressing the *Play* button 1, or re-record using the *Record* button 2. When you're done, press the *Next Step* button 3. If you want to pick a different type of sound, press the *Go Back* button 4.



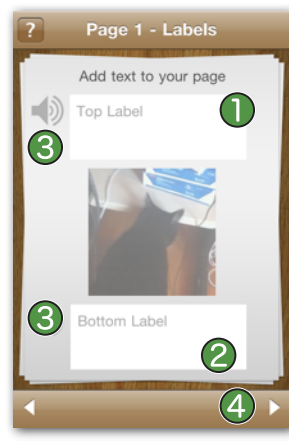
Tap *Add a Page* 1 to add the first page. Each page you add can have picture, a top and bottom label and a sound. The Wizard will walk you through adding each of these in turn, and return you to this screen when each page is completed.



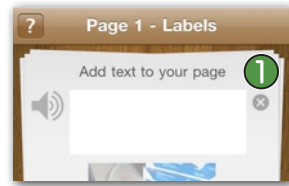
Tap on the picture frame 1 to select or to change a picture. You'll be given choices for where to get a picture, which depend on what kind of device you have. Press 2 to choose from the photos on the device.



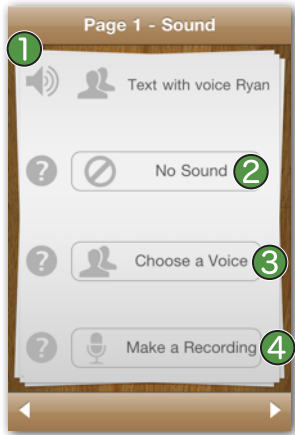
When you have the picture you like, press the *Next Step* button 3.



Touch the text field 1 to type the label on the top of the page, and the text field 2 to type the bottom label. Press the *Done* button on the keyboard to hide the keyboard when you're done. Press the speaker icons 3 to hear your text. Press the *Next Step* button 4 when you're done with the labels.

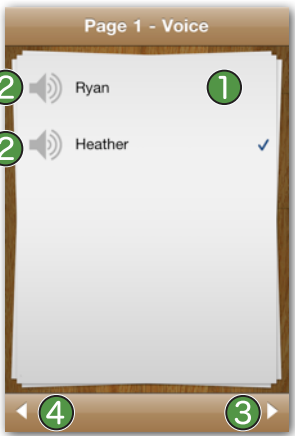


Tip: To delete all the text in a label, tap the label and then tap the small circle with an X inside 1.



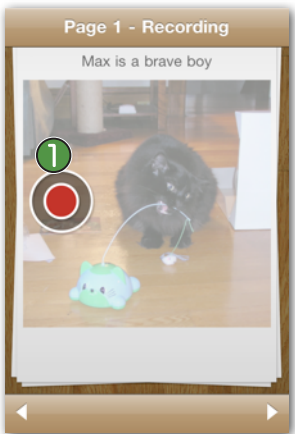
Now you'll choose the sound for your page. The currently chosen sound is at the top of the page. Press 1 speaker to hear how it sounds.

To make a page with no sound, press 2. To choose a different text-to-speech voice, press 3. To record a sound, press 4.

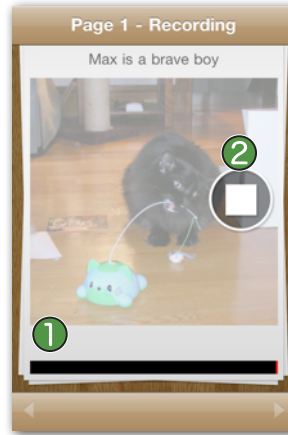


If you pressed *Choose A Voice* on the previous page, you'll see a list of the voices installed in Pictello. The currently chosen voice has a checkmark 1. To hear how your labels will sound with any of the voices, press 2 speaker icon next to the voice name. To choose a different voice, touch the voice's name, and the checkmark will move to the new voice. When you're

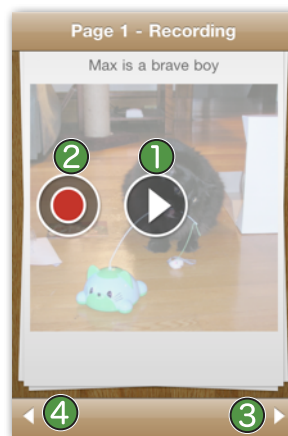
done, press the *Next Step* button 3. If you want to pick a different type of sound, press the *Go Back* button 4.



If you pressed the *Make a Recording* button on the previous page, you'll see a page where you can record any speech or sound you like. When you're ready to record, press the red button 1. If your device does not have a microphone, you will get an error.

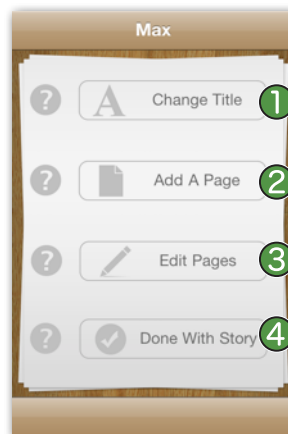


A black bar will appear at the bottom of the page 1, with a red line indicating the recording level (how loud the sound is that the microphone is receiving). The *Record* button will disappear, and a *Stop* button 2 will appear. Press the *Stop* button when you're done recording.



When you stop your recording, the *Record* button will reappear and a *Play* button will also appear. You can listen to your recording by pressing the *Play* button 1, or re-record using the *Record* button 2. When you're done, press the *Next Step* button 3. If you want to pick a different type of sound, press the *Go Back* button 4.

After making your recording or choosing a voice, you'll be returned to the story edit screen.



From this page, you can change the title text or picture of the story 1, add more pages 2, edit pages already in the story 3, or save the story and return to the list of stories 4.
