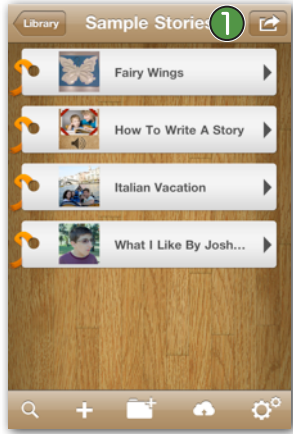


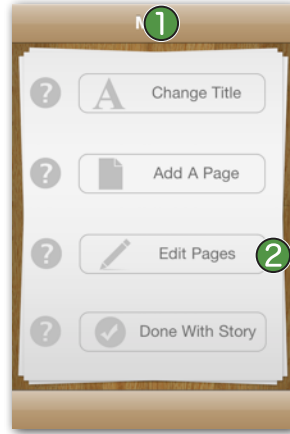


Changing a Story with Pictello Wizard

Pictello is a simple way to create talking photo albums and talking books. Each page in a Pictello Story can contain a picture, up to five lines of text, and a recorded sound or text-to-speech using high-quality voices. In this tutorial you will edit an existing story with the Pictello Wizard Editor.



Find the story you want to edit. Then press the *Action* button ①.

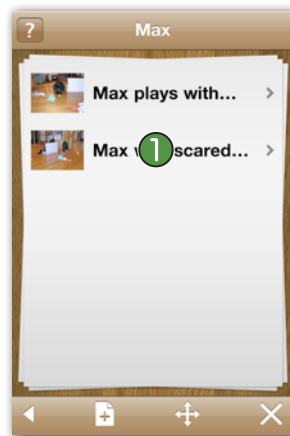


The first screen you will see should look like this ①. To start editing your existing pages, press the *Edit Pages* button ②. If you don't see an *Edit Pages* button, your story doesn't have pages yet; see the tutorial *Creating Stories with Pictello Wizard*.

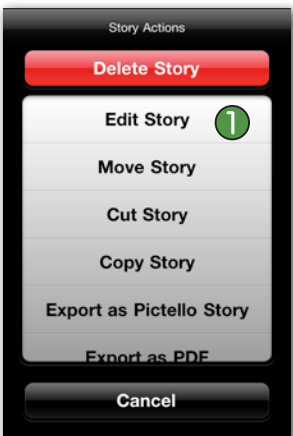


The *Action* button will change to a *Done* button ① and the arrows at the end of the story rows will disappear.

Press the row of the story you want to edit ②.

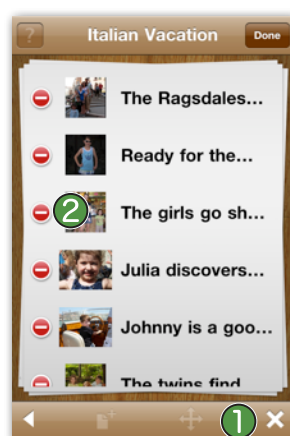


You will see a list of the pages in your story. To change a page, press the row of that page ①. You'll be taken through the same steps you went through when you added the page - see the tutorial *Adding Pages with Pictello Wizard* for details.

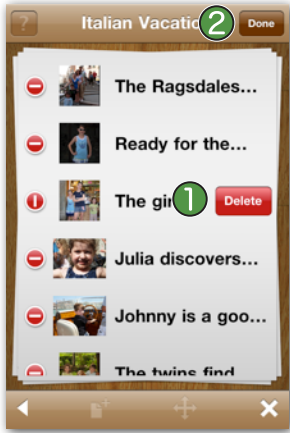


You'll see a list of actions you can perform on this story. Select *Edit Story* ①.

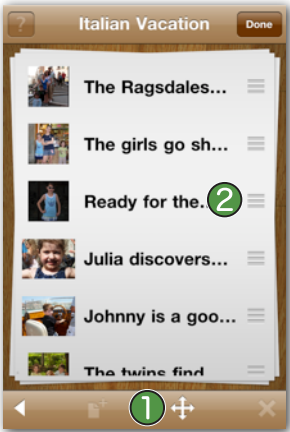
You now either get the choice for Wizard or Expert editing. Choose Wizard. If this choice is not offered and you get into Expert editing mode reset the editing mode to Wizard using the Options panel ③ (above).



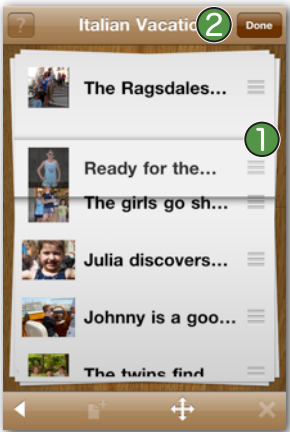
To delete a page, press the *Delete* mode button ①. Red circles will appear on the left end of each row ②. Press the red circle on the row of the page you want to delete.



A *Delete* button ① will appear on the left end of the row you're deleting. Press this button to confirm you want to delete the page, and the page's row will disappear. There is no undoing a page delete. When you're done deleting pages, press the *Done* button ②.



To change the order of the pages, press the *Move* ① button. Three gray bars ② will appear at the right end of each row.



To move a row, drag it by the gray bars ① into the position you want. When you're done moving pages, press the *Done* button ②.

When you're done editing pages, press the *Go Back* button, and you'll be at the first screen in this tutorial.
