



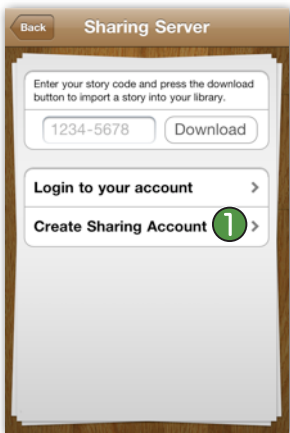
Using the Pictello Sharing Server - Basics

Pictello is a simple way to create talking photo albums and talking books. Each page in a Pictello Story can contain a picture, up to five lines of text, and a recorded sound or text-to-speech using high-quality voices. In this tutorial you will create a sharing server account, export a story to the server, and import a story using a story code.

Create an Account



To export stories to the Pictello Sharing Server, you must have an account. Accounts are free. To create an account, press the *Sharing Server* button ①.

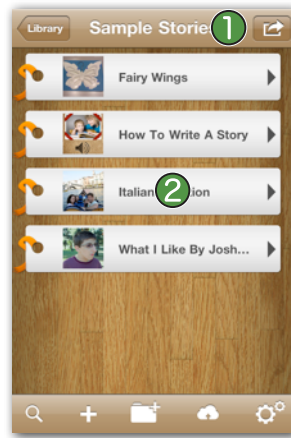


Press the *Create Sharing Account* button ①.

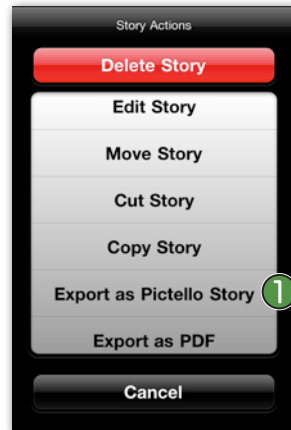


Fill in a user name ① and your first and last name ②. Enter a password ③, which must be at least 4 characters long and contain at least one number. Type the same password in again ④. Next, enter your email address. We will email you at this address if you forget your password and ask us to reset it for you. Last, press *Create Account* ⑥.

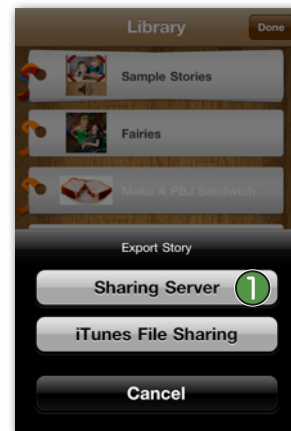
Export a Story to Sharing Server



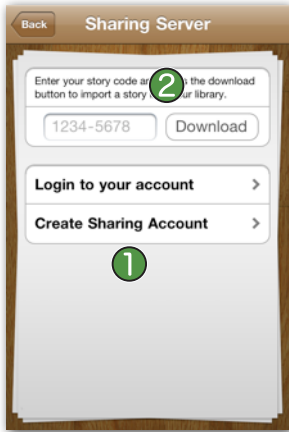
Find the story you want to export, and press the *Action* button ①. Then press the story's row ②.



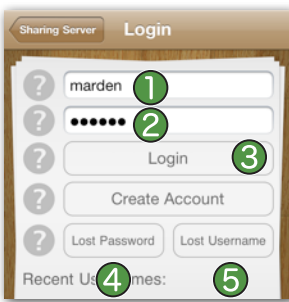
A list of choices will appear. Pick *Export as Pictello Story* ①.



You will be given a choice between the *Sharing Server* and *iTunes File Sharing*. Pick *Sharing Server* ①.

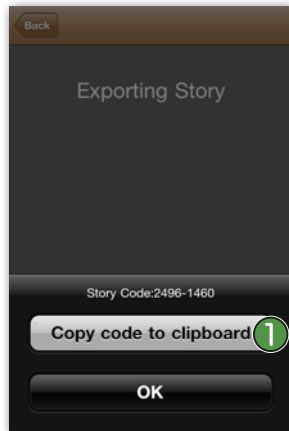


If you haven't logged into your account yet, you'll be asked to give your username and password. Usernames that have recently logged in from this device are listed 1. To pick a name from this list, touch it and it will be entered into the username 2 field. Otherwise, touch the field and a keyboard will appear.

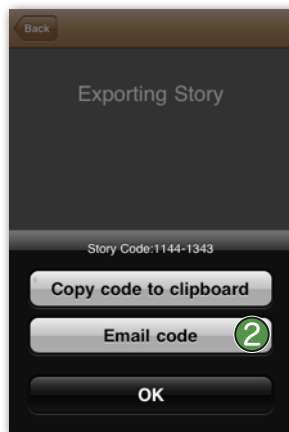


Enter your username 1 and password 2, then press *Login* 3. If you don't remember your password, press *Lost My Password* 4. If you don't remember your username, enter your email in the username field and press *Lost Username* 5.

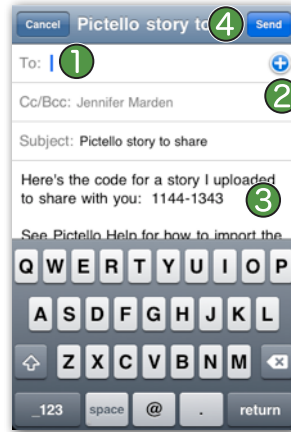
Once you're logged in, your story will be sent to the Sharing Server. The server will send back an 8 digit code which is the "name" of your story on the server. You can save this code to the clipboard, and paste it into another app 1.



If your device is configured to send email, you will be given a choice to email the code 2. If you send the code to someone who has the Pictello app, they can download the story into Pictello on their device. If your device is not configured for email, you will not see the email option.



Enter the email address 1, or



press the + 2 to access your address book. Add any text you like to the message 3, then press *Send* 4 to mail the message.

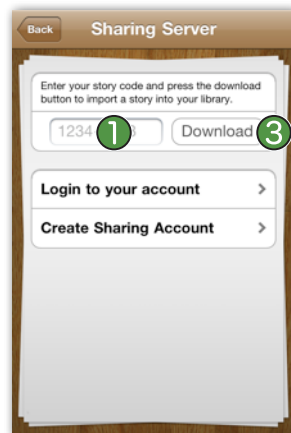
Downloading a Story Using a Code

Make sure you have the story code available. You can use copy and paste from email or any other app that supports copy to get the code.

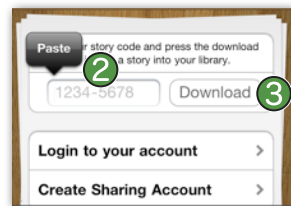


When you have the code, press the *Sharing Server* button 1.

If you didn't copy the code to the clipboard, touch the story code field and type in the code 1.



If you did copy the code from another app, press and hold on the story code field 1, and a *Paste* button 2 will appear. Tap the *Paste* button and the code will be entered.



Press the *Download* button 3 to get the story from the server.
