Respect multimodal communication	Say "now use your talker"
• Use the AAC system to talk yourself	Expect the AAC user to communicate without you modelling how
V Focus on key words when modeling	Think you always need to model grammatically correct sentences
 Allow exploration and access to the whole vocabulary 	Create custom pages for specific activities
Provide wait time	Do all the talking
Ask open-ended questions	Ask questions the AAC user knows you already know the answer to
 Describe what you want to say using core words 	Focus on adding lots of vocabulary
